An Introduction to your AIM Aviation Insurance Policy- For Pleasure Aircraft

Before buying or renewing your aircraft insurance Policy consider the benefits to an AIM Policy – There is more to a Policy than just the Premium!

To know what you are buying we have given you answers to a few regularly asked questions.

WHAT CAN I USE MY AIRCRAFT FOR? Our Policy Defines Private, Business and Pleasure as:-*personal and pleasure use and includes upgrading instruction or use in the direct connection with your business.*

WHEN AND WHERE CAN I USE MY AIRCRAFT? – Our Policy states:- *The Insurance applies to claims arising from occurrences which take place during the Policy period shown on the Declaration Page while your aircraft is within or is en route between these places; Canada, the French Islands of St. Pierre and Miquelon, the Republic of Mexico, the Bahamas, the Islands of the West Indies or the Continental United States of America including Alaska. When your aircraft is in Alaska passenger coverage is restricted to \$300,000 per passenger.*

WHO CAN FLY MY AIRCRAFT. The Policy will state who is allowed to fly your aircraft, however any instructor who is giving you upgrading instruction is automatically covered. Also after you have had maintenance performed the mechanic is permitted to test fly your aircraft.

WHEN I INSURE MY AIRCRAFT WHAT AM I REALLY INSURING? Our Policy defines an aircraft as:- *the landplane, skiplane, floatplane, amphibian or helicopter specifically described in this Policy and shall include i) operating, navigating and radio equipment attached or usually attached thereto, ii) parts temporarily detached from the aircraft and not replaced by other similar parts, iii) alternate undercarriages and their fittings for an aircraft for the configuration as stated in the Declaration Page and iv) tools, repair and survival equipment in the aircraft which are usual for its operation.*

WHAT DEDUCTIBLE WILL APPLY TO MY AIRCRAFT.? - Our standard Deductible for light aircraft is \$500. This is the amount that you have to pay first on any loss. If you want a different deductible - higher or lower then just ask for it. The higher the deductible the more premium you will save. REMEMBER you do not have to pay a deductible if your aircraft is a total loss or damaged by fire, theft, light

DOES AN AIM POLICY COVER PREMISES LIABILITY? We are one of the few companies that automatically this exposure. *Premise Liability means the immediate parking area, tiedown area or storage area where your aircraft is stored, but must not be owned in whole or in part by you.*

DOES AN AIM POLICY HAVE ANY IMMEDIATE DEATH BENEFITS? AIM will pay immediately upon request **\$10,000** if a Passenger or a Pilot dies in an insured aircraft to help cover any expenses i.e. travel, funeral etc.

WHAT COVERAGES CAN I BUY TO PROTECT MY AIRCRAFT? Our Policy will give you three types of coverage you can buy.
All Risks In flight and Ground. All Risk ground excluding taxiing or All Risks ground including taxiing.

WHAT LIABILITY COVERAGES CAN I BUY TO PROTECT ME? You have a choice of Buying protection for Property Damage, Bodily injury to other people either including passengers or excluding passengers. You can purchase as much as 10 million dollars coverage to protect yourself. The choice is yours and your Broker will assist you if you ask your Broker for their recommendations.

WHEN I BUY LIABILITY COVERAGES WHAT ELSE DOES THE POLICY GIVE ME AS EXTRA COVERAGE?

Emergency Charges - For charges made by others to you arising out of emergency conditions for; i) Foaming of a runway preceding any emergency or crash landing; ii) Fire, crash control and rescue; iii) Search and rescue. The maximum that we will pay for these expenses will not exceed \$50,000 for any one occurrence.

First Aid - For expenses that you incur for immediate first aid arising out of an occurrence.

Violation Costs - We will provide a maximum of \$5,000 for the cost to defend a legal action against any approved named pilot under this Policy in the event that an Aviation Authority takes action against that pilot for a violation arising out of an occurrence. We will not however be responsible to provide a defense or pay any fines.

Baggage - i) Personal baggage of a passenger who is not injured but not exceeding a limit of \$5,000 each passenger; ii) An aircraft hangar or contents thereof, but not exceeding \$50,000 any one occurrence.

Defense and Defense costs - We will defend any lawsuit brought against you seeking damages for bodily injury or property damage for which Coverage is provided in this Policy even if the lawsuit is groundless, false or fraudulent.

CAN I USE SOMEONE ELSE'S AIRCRAFT? - This is commonly called Non Owned Aircraft Liability and will protect you if you are legally liable. Remember though that you must be legally liable so if you rented an aircraft and the engine failed due to the owners fault then you may not be liable.

"Provided you have purchased Coverages A,F or G, then subject to all terms, conditions and exclusions, those Coverages purchased are extended to apply to the use of any aircraft by you in the event a claim is made or a suit is brought against you provided that:

1. *You do not use the aircraft for commercial purposes.*
2. *The aircraft is not leased to or owned in whole or in part by, or registered in your name, or that of any member of your family or household.*
3. *The number of seats in the aircraft does not exceed the maximum number of seats in an aircraft insured under the Declaration Page of this Policy.*
4. *The maximum amount of insurance available, regardless of the amount you purchased for your aircraft for this section is \$200,000 and is subject to a deductible of one percent of the final determined value of the aircraft.*
5. *The aircraft is not a float aircraft, multi-engine aircraft, helicopter, ultralight, or balloon, unless the existing aircraft insured under this Policy is one of these types."*

WHAT ARE SOME THINGS WE WONT COVER? *We will not cover losses arising out of the aircraft being over gross take off weight, noise and pollution, misrepresentation, radio active contamination, wear and tear, loss of use to your aircraft embezzlement, property owned by you, intentional injury, fines punitive damage, your employees and claims covered by Workers Compensation.*
